**Cylindrical batteries and fluorescent tubes will be collected in the 1<sup>st</sup> week of February.**

Please separate these from other garbage and individually put them into transparent or semi-transparent plastic bags, then take them out to a designated area on the collection day for non-burnable small garbage between February 2<sup>nd</sup> (Mon) and 6<sup>th</sup> (Fri). Please be sure to put fluorescent tubes into something resembling the original package so that they are not broken.

Only for areas whose the garbage collection service days match the national holiday. Please be sure to take garbage out by 8 a.m..
