The 35th Anniversary Chinese Cloisonne Ware Association Exhibit is held until May 15 (Sun).

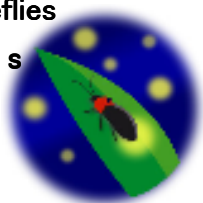
