※ Collection of Dry-Cell Batteries, Fluorescent Bulbs and Tubes

Please put dry-cell batteries into fully or semi-transparent bags. We suggest that you use original cases for fluorescent bulbs and tubes so that they don't break easily. Then take them out on the day for non-burnable small garbage collection between February 1 (Thu) and February 7 (Wed).
