J-ALERT is a nationwide instantaneous warning system of the cabinet office and fire department, aimed to transmit emergency messages of earthquakes, tsunamis, armed attacks, etc. We will conduct a nationwide simultaneous information transmission training using J-ALERT. During this training, we will broadcast information through disaster prevention radios. Since this is no actual disaster information, please stay calm and don't panic.

Garbage Collection Services for Holidays (Tottori Area)

The garbage collection day will be changed as below when the day is a national holiday in your area.

※ Collection of Dry-Cell Batteries, Fluorescent Bulbs and Tubes

Please put dry-cell batteries into fully or semi-transparent bags. We suggest that you use original cases for fluorescent bulbs and tubes so that they don' t break easily. Then take them out on the day for non-burnable small garbage collection between June 1st (Fri) and June 7th (Thu). (Tottori Area)

※ Please do not dispose of medical waste at the garbage collection point.

In case you need to dispose of medical waste, ask your primary medical institution for disposing it.
