●Collection of Dry-Cell Batteries, Fluorescent Bulbs and Tubes in June●

Please put dry-cell batteries into fully or semi-transparent bags. We suggest that you use original cases for fluorescent bulbs and tubes so that they don't break easily. Then take them out on the day for non-burnable small garbage collection between June 1st (Fri) and June 7th (Thu). (Tottori Area)

【Please do not dispose of medical waste at the garbage collection point.】

In case you need to dispose of medical waste, ask your primary medical institution for disposing it.

●Caution! Unlawful Dumping of Garbage is a Crime!●

If you don't follow the rules of how to dispose your garbage and throw or bury it in the forest or an empty lot, it will be regarded as an act of illegal dumping. So please make sure to follow the rules, otherwise you will be fined.
