■Garbage Collection Services during the Holidays (Tottori Area)※Please take out your garbage by 8am.

◆Please take out your garbage only on the garbage day. In case there are natural disasters, for example typhoon, heavy rains, flood, heavy snow, earth quake, etc., be cautious when you take out your garbage. If you feel difficulties disposing garbage due to the natural disaster, wait until the next garbage day.

※Collection of Dry-Cell Batteries, Fluorescent Bulbs and Tubes in October

Please separate these things from other garbage and put them into fully or semi-transparent bags. Then take them out on the day for non-burnable small garbage collection between November 3rd (Mon) and November 7th (Fri).
