●Collection of Dry-Cell Batteries, Fluorescent Bulbs and Tubes in April●

Please put dry-cell batteries into fully or semi-transparent bags. We suggest that you use original cases for fluorescent bulbs and tubes so that they don't break easily. Then take them out on the day for non-burnable small garbage collection between April 1<sup>st</sup> (Tue) and April 7<sup>th</sup> (Mon). (Tottori Area)
